Does your child LOVE coming to gymnastics?

Flip n Twist has created another unique opportunity for our students in the Kindergym/ Level 1, Level 2, and Level 3 programs. Is your child interested in being on a competitive team but doesn't know what to expect? Does your child constantly do gymnastics at home? Does your child want opportunities to perform the skills she learns in class each week? Then come join our Kinder/ Level 1, Level 2, and Level 3 Non-competitive In-House Team. There is NO EXPERIENCE required and tryouts aren't necessary to be on these teams. If you are interested in being on one of these teams, stop by the front desk and leave your name and number. The program director will give you a call to schedule an evaluation for your child. (an evaluation is necessary to ensure placement on appropriate team) In house Teams will take part in three in house meets, have a "team" leotard, shirt and bag. The In House Teams will also take part in team activities/ outings. This is a great way to let your child use their gymnastics for something fun and rewarding!
